ref: Launch of the Project “Climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in Tulcea municipality”

January 2023

The Ministry of the Environment, Water and Forests is the Program Operator for the Program “Environment, adaptation to climate change and ecosystems” (Ro-Environment), Small Grants Scheme “Elaboration of mitigation and adaptation plans to climate change in municipalities”, and is financed by Financial Mechanism of EEA European Economic Area 2014-2021.

UAT Tulcea Municipality signed, on November 24, 2022, non-refundable financing contract no.25239/BT/24.11.2022 for the implementation of the project: “Climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in the municipality of Tulcea”. The partner of UAT Tulcea municipality in the development of the project is Bucharest National Research and Development Institute for Environmental Protection, specialized in fundamental/ applied research activities and technological development, in the field of engineering and environmental protection.

The total value of the project is 584,832 lei, of which 85% non-refundable eligible value from MF SEE 497,107.20 lei, 15% non-refundable eligible value from the national budget 87,724.80 lei and the implementation period is November 24, 2022- November 24, 2023.

The general objective of the project is the preparation of the climate change adaptation and mitigation plan for the municipality of Tulcea.

The specific objectives of the project are:

- Informing and involving stakeholders
- Inventory of greenhouse gas emissions
- Current and forecast climate analysis
- Analysis of risks and vulnerabilities to climate change
- Identification and description of actions to complete the climate change adaptation and mitigation plan of municipality of Tulcea.

Expected results of projects are related to national and EU policies in the field of climate change.

The main outputs will consist of vulnerability indicators and risk scores. The assessment of adaptation capacity will be carried out by assigning indicators from categories such as: access to services, governmental and institutional capacity, physical and environmental capacity, knowledge and innovation.
