### The launch conference of the project "Climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in the municipality of Tulcea"

February 2023

Tulcea City Hall, together with its partner the Bucharest National Institute for Research and Development for Environmental Protection (INCDDPM), launched, on Friday, February 10, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. (Tulcea City Hall headquarters), the "Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Plan" project in the municipality of Tulcea" financed by the Ministry of Environment, Water and Forests, through the RO-Environment Program with financing through the Financial Mechanism of the European Economic Area (EEA) 2014-2021.

The total value of the project is 584,832 lei, of which 85% non-refundable eligible value from the SEE MF 497,107.20 lei, 15% non-refundable eligible value from the national budget 87,724.80 lei, and the implementation period is 12 months (November 24, 2022 - 24 November 2023).

During the event, it was discussed the importance of launching such plans, which aim to achieve neutrality from the point of view of climate change in a specific time horizon - 2050 - to protect the environment and stimulate the green economy.

Presentations of the project were made, starting from the general objective, to the specific objectives of the project, namely the inventory of greenhouse gas emissions, the analysis of the current and forecasted climate, the analysis of risks and vulnerabilities to climate change, the identification and description of actions to complete the plan of adaptation and mitigation to climate change of the municipality of Tulcea.

Expected outputs will consist of vulnerability indicators and risk scores. The assessment of adaptation capacity will be carried out by assigning indicators from categories such as: access to services, governmental and institutional capacity, physical and environmental capacity, knowledge and innovation.

At the launch Conference of the "Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Plan in the Municipality of Tulcea" project, representatives of institutions, environmental authorities, commercial companies, NGOs, mass media, with roles significant in the implementation of the measures within the Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Plan in the municipality of Tulcea. Thus, representatives of the Chamber of Deputies, the Prefect's Institution, the County Council, APM, ARBDD, INCDD, the County School Inspectorate, the Forestry Directorate, SC AQUASERV SA, SC Energoterm SA, SC Public Transport SA, SC Servicii Publice SA, SC Flash Lightning were present.
