*Ref: Progress workshop within the project "Elaboration of the mitigation and adaptation plan to climate change in the municipality of Tulcea"*

April 2023

Tulcea City Hall, together with its partner, the Bucharest National Institute for Research and Development for Environmental Protection (INCDPM), organized on Wednesday, April 26, 2023, the first progress workshop of the project: "Elaboration of the climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in the municipality of Tulcea".

The Ministry of the Environment, Water and Forests is the Program Operator for the Program "Environment, adaptation to climate change and ecosystems" (RO-Environment), Small Grants Scheme "Elaboration of mitigation plans and adaptation to climate change in municipalities" and is financed by the Mechanism Financial of the EEA European Economic Area 2014-2021.

The total value of the project is 584,832 lei, and the implementation period is 12 months (November 24, 2022 - November 24, 2023).

During the event, it was discussed about the stages of project development, the contribution that each institution can bring to the creation of the inventory of greenhouse gas emissions, the outline of the current and forecasted climate, the analysis of risks and vulnerabilities and the identification of feasible measures for the mitigation and adaptation plan climate changes in the municipality of Tulcea.

In an interactive way, the representatives of the local public administration, environmental institutions, research and administration institutes of the Danube Delta, and relevant NGOs, contributed to the achievement of the objectives of the first progress workshop of the climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in the municipality of Tulcea.

Expected outputs will consist of vulnerability indicators and risk scores. The assessment of adaptation capacity will be carried out by assigning indicators from categories such as: access to services, governmental and institutional capacity, physical and environmental capacity, knowledge and innovation.
