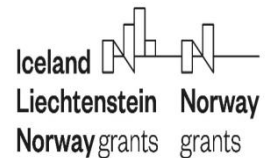

"Climate change mitigation and adaptation plan in the municipality of Tulcea" Tulcea, February, 2024

The Municipality of Tulcea, as the Beneficiary, organized on February 26, 2024, the Closing Conference of the "Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation Plan in the Municipality of Tulcea" project.

This project has a total value of 584,832 lei, and was implemented by the Ministry of Environment, Water and Forests, through the "Environment, Adaptation to Climate Change and Ecosystems" Program - RO-Environment, as Program Operator, financed by the Financial Mechanism of the European Economic Area (EEA) 2014-2021. The implementation period of a project is November 24, 2022 - February 29, 2024.

The partner of the Municipality of Tulcea in the development of the project is the Bucharest National Research and Development Institute for Environmental Protection, specializing in fundamental/applied research activities and technological development, in the field of engineering and environmental protection.

The general objective of the project consists in the development of the climate change adaptation and mitigation plan for the municipality of Tulcea, which assumed the fulfillment of specific objectives: the inventory of greenhouse gas emissions, the analysis of the current and forecasted climate, the analysis of risks and vulnerabilities, the identification and description actions to complete the climate change adaptation and mitigation plan.

The project targets all components of society and all economic sectors, from the energy sector to industry, transport, buildings, agriculture and the measures that need to be taken for the climate and environment, to conserve and protect the planet, so as to improve the way we live, we move around, heat or cool our homes, as well as how we produce and consume.
